- Since the focus of MCA programme is to build such skills that would enable the MCA graduates to develop software applications, Kindly design courses that would help in this. In this regard it suggested incorporating lab component wherever feasible. Operating system with hands-on lab in Linux and system programming would be better.

- vi. The Operating System course should include topics related to Microsoft Windows, Apple MAC OS, Linux, Android and Apple's iOS.
- vii. The power of Microsoft Excel should be learned by the students and this can be included in appropriate course.
 - vii. The internship should include live projects or outsourcing work experience.
- is. The Business intelligence/Data Analytics should include text mining, optimization and Data visualization topics.
 - x. The Business intelligence, ERP courses can be give as special electives.
- ii. The Internet of Things course should include topics related to Acquiring and sorting IoT Data, Reprocessing and transformations and Analytics for business insights
 - xi. 10T frameworks and Sensors. Internships in IoT should be encouraged.

- xiv. Software testing course can be provided giving emphasis to automation test tools and selenium software.
 - nv. Special Electives related to IT infrastructure Management can be included.

Mr. S. Saravanan (Alumni Member) suggested the following,

- i.In Elective III group, ASP.NET and C#.NET Programming is Part of .NET Programming, we can combine these two courses into one course.
- ii. After combining the above courses into one course we can introduce "Mobile Development" course in Elective III group.

It is suggested to add lab component for such courses which have industrial and research importance.
