- Rain water collection and storage system has been created and the rain water collected is used for wash room and gardening purposes

Students were allowed to use BYOD lab with Wifi facility. This enabled the students to take up a total of around 130 topic-wise, full-length and company-specific online assessments through Skillrack and E Box along with additional online practices not only enhanced the students' learning abilities but also boosted their confidence level. Based on the scores

obtained, class-wise ranking was done and top scorers were recognised and appreciated. The results were displayed in the respective classrooms which helped them to understand where they stood. Also the slow learners were identified and additional coaching was given to them.

Reference books for Aptitude were given to all the final year students for extensive practice. Exclusive Soft Skills sessions were conducted with focus on topics such as Public Speaking, Body Language, Personal Grooming, Interview Skills, Mock GD Sessions etc that eventually helped students to go through the recruitment process confidently.
